
80th New England Complex Fluids Workshop Brandeis University September 20, 2019



If you are walking from the train, first cross South St, head north and enter campus (on your left). Navigate through dormitories and proceed to the <u>Shapiro Campus Center</u>. It takes 5 minutes to walk. Don't stop at Shapiro Admissions, Shapiro Science Center, or Shapiro Athletic Facility!

Registration (and coffee / lunch) are in the Shapiro Campus Center, room 236. Meeting is in the Shapiro Theater, located on the ground floor.

If you are driving, enter Brandeis at the main entrance located north of the railroad tracks on South St. and ask the guard for a T-lot parking sticker. If there are no guards, proceed to T-lot and park. Walk back the way you drove in. When you arrive at the intersection with the circular campus road you will see the Shapiro Campus Center in front of you. If you get a parking ticket, please give it to us and we'll tear it up for you!
